Robin's richly illustrated talk about his experiences in two very different wild environments focusses on two types of bear. First the Polar Bear, photographed in Churchill, Canada, a harsh habitat where the bears gather on the shore of Hudson bay, waiting for

it to freeze so that they can cross it and hunt for seals. And then the Alaskan Brown Bears that spend just a few months in Silver Salmon Creek more than 3,000km away in Alaska, to feed on migrating salmon to provide nourishment for their cubs.
